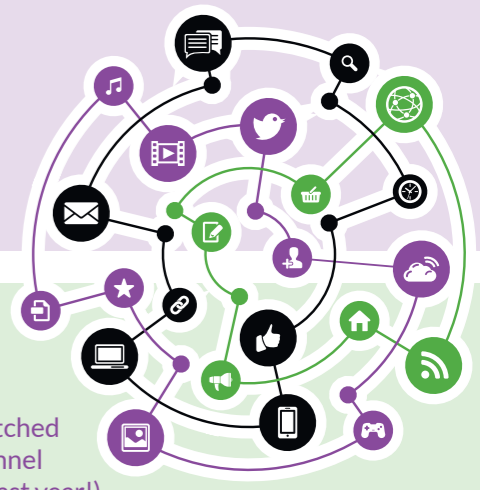


OUR ACHIEVEMENTS DURING COVID-19

Pendle Community Support Hub

44 members of staff helped to man a community hub 7 days a week to support the borough's most vulnerable residents during the pandemic



4,000 people PLT staff helped through the community support hub

shielding residents who PLT staff contacted on behalf of the NHS to offer support

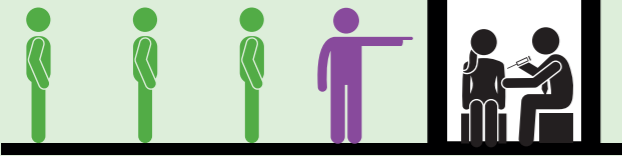


YouTube

- **£183,000** - Pendle Council received from Sport England's National Leisure Recovery Fund to financially support Pendle Leisure Trust in reopening its facilities
- **£185,543** - The lifeline grant PLT received from the Government's Culture Recovery Fund
- **£3,583** - The grant The Muni Theatre received from The Theatres Trust Reopening Fund to help with costs of COVID-secure reopening

The Feelgood Factory at Pendle Leisure Centre reopened with a BRAND NEW range of 12 power-assisted machines



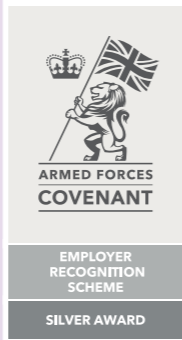
2,000 food parcels were created and distributed by members of staff who helped to run a Food Bank at The ACE Centre
